May Trucking Company was one of 40 companies, representing less than one percent of EPA SmartWay’s nearly 3,000 Partners, to receive this distinction. The award for truck and multimodal carrier Partners were announced at the American Trucking Association’s Annual Management Conference & Exhibition in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Founded in 1945, May Trucking Company Corporate Headquarters is located in Brooks, Oregon with locations in Payette (Idaho), Layton (Utah), Phoenix (Arizona), Denver (Colorado), Gary (Indiana), and Pensacola (Florida). May Trucking Company operates a fleet of over 1,000 tractors throughout the United States transporting dry and temperature controlled products for select business associates.

EPA launched SmartWay in 2004 to help business improve the sustainability of their freight supply chains. Today the Partnership consists of nearly 3,000 Partners, representing a cross section of the freight supply chain industry. As of today, SmartWay Partners have saved 55 million barrels of oil. This is equivalent to taking over 3 million cars off the road for an entire year. SmartWay’s clean air achievements (23.6 million metric tons of carbon dioxide, 478,000 tons nitrogen oxides, and 22,000 tons of particulate matter reduced so far) help protect the health and well being of citizens while contributing to our nation’s economic and energy security.
